## Japanese Knotweed

This invasive exotic plant threatens our biodiversity and is difficult to eradicate.

Often confused with Sakhalin or Bohemian knotweed, it requires preventive measures to limit its spread. Note that cutting stems alone, without damaging the rhizomes, does not eliminate a colony. Cutting a colony only once will stimulate it instead of harming it. Do you spot one? Report it using the sentinel tool.
