TENNIS and PICKLEBALL COURTS ACCESSIBLE TO THE COMMUNITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WENTWORTH

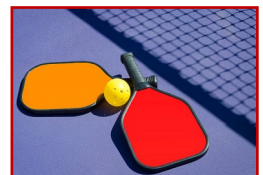


The LLSC is a non-profit organization that offers activities and events throughout an 8-week summer program for members of all ages, from children to seniors. Grateful for the partnership with the Municipality that continues again this summer, it is with great pleasure that the Lake Louisa Social Club opening access to its (2) tennis courts to the population of the Township of Wentworth (members and non-members).

In response to the high demand last year, the courts have also been equipped with pickleball lines.

It is up to you to choose which one you wish to pay on:

- **Location:** Lake Louisa Social Club - 132 Lake Louisa South Rd.
- **Schedule:** Sunday from 8:30am to 11:30am & Tuesday from 5pm to 9pm
- **Period:** from now until October 1st, 2022
- **Matches must be limited to 45 minutes**



In addition, a multi-level tennis program is also offered by the LLSC for members and non-members. Participants, from 4 years old to adults, will be able to take lessons taught by qualified instructors. Please contact the LLSC for more information.
