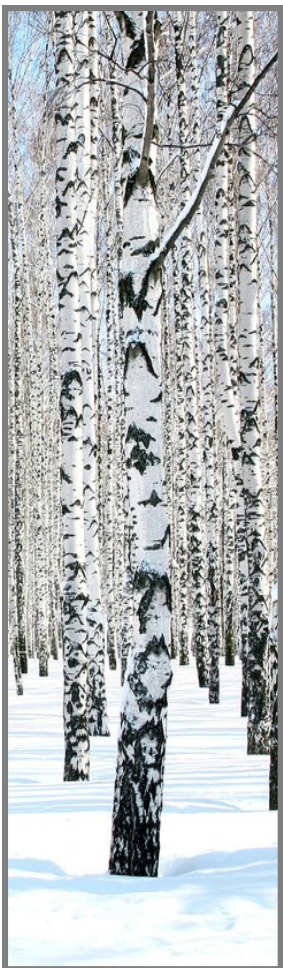
Due to the limited amount of spaces, the Municipal Council suggests mandating a representative for a group or association.
