PURSUANT TO THE ACT RESPECTING THE REMUNERATION OF ELECTED OFFICIALS, PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN BY THE UNDERSIGNED that at the regular meeting held on December 5th, 2022, the Municipal Council deposited the Draft By-Law number 2023-002 concerning the salaries of Elected Municipal Officials.

Base Salary:

ELECTED	CURRENT SALARY 2022	PROPOSED SALARY 2023
Mayor	\$ 21,000	\$ 24,000
Councillor	\$ 7,000	\$ 7,476

Additional remuneration:

An additional remuneration established at \$50.00 per meeting attended shall be granted to the President of the Urbanism Consulting Committee (UCC).

Expense Allowance:

The expense allowance remains an amount equal to one-half of each Elected Official's base salary.

Indexation:

The basic salary of Elected Officials shall be indexed upward annually by a percentage corresponding to the rates of increase of the Consumer Price Index for Canada established by Statistics Canada as of September 30th of the previous year for each subsequent fiscal year.

Retroactive effect:

The By-Law shall be retroactive to January 1st, 2023, and shall replace By-Law number 2022-002.

This By-Law is scheduled for adoption at the regular meeting to be held on January 9th, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at the Wentworth Town Hall located at 175 Louisa Road, Wentworth.
